Organization Background

ASMITA is a registered charitable trust founded in 1998 in Varanasi, Uttar Pradesh, working for the dignity and empowerment of marginalised migrant labourers, widows, and children in the city's slums through education, vocational training, health interventions and rescue-rehabilitation.

Project Details

Project Sunrise works directly in 10 slums of Varanasi to empower 800–900 adolescents. Animators are the frontline facilitators who engage young people and their families in the community every day.

Roles & Responsibilities

- Conduct education-support classes, life-skills and awareness sessions for adolescents
- Mobilise children, adolescents and families to participate in programme activities
- Identify out-of-school and at-risk children and support their inclusion
- Maintain attendance registers, activity records and individual progress reports
- Support the Coordinator in planning and implementing field activities
- Build rapport with the community and local stakeholders
